SIGHT-SEEING TOURS

Somerset

One day. You can take a one-way or return trip by ferry using your bicycle around Somerset. See Somerset Bridge, smallest drawbridge in the world; Fort Scour, historic fortress with commanding view; Springfield Library; the magnificent panoramas from Gibb's Hill Lighthouse.

St. George's

One day. (See St. George's Map.) Among the many places of historical interest are: St. Peter's Church, oldest Anglican Church site in the Western Hemisphere; Old State House, first stone building erected in Bermuda; St. George's Historical Society Museum, with prints and relics of early Bermuda; Featherbed Alley Print Shop; Tucker House, where the Duke of Clarence, later King William IV of England, lived; Gates' Fort; Fort St. Catherine, with the Crown Jewels

of England in replica, period restorations and historic dioramas; the Carriage Museum, unique collection of old Bermuda carriages; the Old Rectory; Confederate Museum; Somers Garden, memorial to Admiral Sir George Somers; Gunpowder Cavern; Stocks, Pillory and Whipping Post in King's Square; St. David's Lighthouse.


City of Hamilton

Half-day or longer. (See Hamilton Map.) Take a leisurely tour by foot and visit shops and restaurants along with these places of interest: Par-la-ville Gardens, Bermuda Library and Historical Society Museum, with a fine collection of ships' models, maps and antiques; the Perot Post Office; beautiful City Hall and Bermuda Society of Arts Galleries; Bermuda Cathedral; Sessions House, home of the second oldest Parliament in the British Commonwealth.
